

**Categorizing Observations and Inferences Sample**

<b>Observations</b>	<b>Corresponding Inferences</b>
<b>#1:</b> Most students finished the assignment twenty minutes before the end of the class.	<b>#4:</b> The assignment Mr. Truong gave was far too easy for students.
<b>#2:</b> When asked to share their responses to the assignment with the rest of the class, more than half of the students did not contribute.	<b>#11:</b> Many students in the class were not able to complete the assignment.
<b>#8:</b> Several students nearly fell asleep during the class.	<b>#3:</b> Students were extremely bored by the lesson.
<b>#7:</b> Students asked many questions after Mr. Truong introduced and described the assignment to the class.	<b>#5:</b> Students did not seem to understand what they were being asked to do for the main assignment.
<b>#6:</b> Several students asked if they could work on the assignment with a partner or in groups.	<b>#10:</b> All students would rather work in groups as opposed to individual work.
<b>#12:</b> There was lots of chatter while students completed the assignment.	<b>#9:</b> Students were not concentrating on the assignment as they completed it.
